

# SolShare pre-installation checklist

## For solar salespeople, designers and installers

Prior to going to site to install and commission a solar system with SolShare, the installation team must have the following information to hand. This will enable the installation team to perform the installation, correctly fill out the SolShare tenancy connections page provided in the installation kit, and successfully configure each SolShare's operational settings in the [SolShare Commissioning App](#).

## Required information prior to installation

- Access to Allume's [SolShare installation training course](#) (**must be completed prior to commencing any SolShare installation and/or commissioning activities**).
  - The person commissioning SolShare using the [SolShare Commissioning App](#) must have **their own** training certificate number (provided in the certificate upon completing the SolShare installation training course).
- SLD/s for this project, including information about each tenancy (and common area, if applicable):
  - Which phase/s to connect to SolShare.
  - Which SolShare to connect to (for multi-SolShare projects).
- The address of the installation site.
- The DC solar system size (in kW) connected to each SolShare.
- The total AC inverter power rating (in kW) connected to each SolShare.
- The inverter brand/s.
- The serial number of each SolShare/s to be installed (these can be found on the bottom right side of the SolShare enclosures themselves once unpacked).
- Which solar sharing mode (recommended: **custom allocation**) that each SolShare will be using (and the allocation for each tenancy).
- The solar installation company's electrical license number.
- Equipment and any configuration information required to provide each SolShare with a strong and stable internet connection
  - SolShare 1 supports 2.4GHz Wi-Fi only
  - SolShare 2 supports Ethernet or 2.4GHz Wi-Fi
